Minutes of the Physics Board Meeting

Agenda:

- Kickoff of a PANDA Physics paper;

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PG introduces the first point of the agenda and ask to the conveners their opinion on this enterprise.

A general discussion take place. All the conveners are in favor of preparing a paper on "Day-1" PANDA physics program.

The things that have been underlined are:

- we should not only limit to describe the possibilities of the initial data taking, but also underline the best possibilities will be offered by the full setup;
- we have to stick to the "Day-1" PANDA detector that is the one presented by the spokesman in the FAIR Council report. LS will make available the setup to everybody.

FM stresses that the paper should be realized in a short time-line (<6 months). This is to give the German government the proof that the collaboration has reacted to the Heuer review.

There is also the need to prepare a report for the new FAIR Council.

FN points out that if we have to rush we have not much time for new simulations.

SS says that in general the Day-1 detector should be available in the simulation setup, but forward tracking is not yet complete and secondary vertex finding needs still tuning.

After discussion it is agreed to use as a basis of the work for the FAIR Scientific Council the writeup made by PG summarizing the Uppsala meeting.
